Mixed and Infants' Division: -

The school is conducted  
 in a progressive spirit, and has reached  
 a stage of attainments and intelligence which  
 suggests latent power not yet stimulated to

its fullest capacity. Some exercises in Composition and Arithmetic worked during the inspection show this. They indicate slowness rather than a want of understanding and knowledge.

The scholars respond with a good will and useful features of the work may be seen in -

1. The well prepared questions for testing the term's work.
2. The careful written answers of the children showing a good range of study each term.
3. The keen interest in private reading in the 1<sup>st</sup> class.
4. The direct questions of the children to obtain guidance from their teachers when in a difficulty.
5. The interest taken in the needlework.

The middle section of the School is carefully taught and useful preliminary work is done ready for the next stage. The weakest part of the school lies in the Infants' Division, which has recently changed teachers. It would be wise to improve the Reading very considerably during the next few months.
