"Considering that this School has only been
 under Mr. Meers charge for six months it may
 be said to be quite satisfactory. The standards
 under which the children were last examined
 could not be ascertained. All now gives promise
 of going on ~~very~~ well. Assistance is required
 for the infants especially as they are in a separate
 Room. The Grant has incurred a deduction under
 Article 17 d for the months during which the School
 was not under the charge of a Certifi^d Teacher.
